

# Case Studies: Field Hospitals

## [ MOBILE FORWARD FIELD HOSPITAL – MALI ]



We designed, manufactured, deployed, staffed, equipped, and operated a mobile and rapidly deployable Damage Control Surgery capability for EUTM in Mali. Packed into three standard-sized ISO containers, this mobile unit significantly extended the mission's reach across Mali while ensuring adherence to the 10-1-2 clinical timeline rule. This pathway prioritises assessment, resuscitation, and the prompt transfer of a patient to a facility capable of effectively managing the injuries sustained - providing life-saving treatment within 10 minutes, extraction to a damage control resuscitation facility within one hour, and evacuation to the next level of care for

## [ MULTIDISCIPLINARY FIELD HOSPITAL – KOSOVO ]

We designed, built, staffed, equipped, and currently operate a Field Hospital in Kosovo, delivering comprehensive medical support for NATO. Our services encompass Damage Control Surgery, Damage Control Resuscitation, Intensive Care, Primary Health Care, Dental Services, and all associated support services, including pharmacy, radiology, laboratory, blood tests, medications, and consumables. This 'turnkey' solution includes a purpose-built facility operational in just 9 weeks, 23 clinical staff, along with teams to provide management, facilities management and supply chain.



## [ DEPLOYED FIELD CLINIC – BANGLADESH ]



We designed, deployed, staffed, and equipped a Primary Healthcare Clinic in Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh, for UNHCR. The clinic provides essential primary healthcare services, health promotion, and diagnostic services to all UN staff supporting the Rohingya refugee crisis, addressing the absence of adequate local facilities. The two-staff clinic provides routine general practice appointments, pre-hospital emergency capabilities, and a limited holding capacity for onward evacuation of serious cases to hospital facilities.
