Iqarus rapidly deployed an Aeromedical Evacuation Team (AMET) to provide critical evacuation services for the United Nations, supporting military and operational needs in Somalia. We deliver 24/7/365 far forward medical care for UNSOS, ATMIS, SNF, and other entitled personnel, both in Mogadishu and at outlying duty stations.

Since 2012, Iqarus has embedded itself in Somalia's complex and volatile environment, consistently delivering medical support despite the challenging political and security landscape. Our ability to adapt and maintain mission readiness ensures that military personnel receive the care they need when it matters most.

 Seamlessly integrating into the UNSOS Mass Casualty Contingency Plan, effectively managing surges in patient loads during mass casualty incidents.

#### **Rapid Deployment Success:**

 Achieving Full Operating Capability (FOC) in Mogadishu and all AMET Sub-Team locations within 30 days of contract signature.

#### **Unmatched Operational Capabilities:**

- Delivered high-quality care despite high patient turnover.
- Maintaining 24-hour operational capability, including night evacuations using night vision goggles.
- Conducted evacuation missions in highly kinetic warfighting zones.
- Providing continuous support during periods of military transition and high patient volumes.
- Demonstrating effective command and control in rapidly changing political and security environments.
