
### Key Achievements

Our AMET comprises Specialist Doctors (Anaesthesia, emergency medicine, aero-medicine, or equivalent), Specialist Nurses (Anaesthesia, intensive care, critical care, or emergency care), and Specialist Flight Paramedics.
